THE DIVIDED KINGDOM

1 KINGS 12-16: THE FIRST 80 YEARS 3012

READING (IN THIS ORDER!):

1 Kings 12 1 Kings 13 1 Kings 14:1-18	The kingdom is divided. The sin of Jeroboam. Israel's new religion condemned. Jeroboam is cursed by the Lord.
2 Chron. 11:5-23 2 Chron. 12 2 Chron. 13	Rehoboam's reign. The Levites forsake Israel. Rehoboam forsakes the Law, and is punished. Rehoboam dies, and Abijah ("Abijam" in <u>Kings</u>), becomes king in Judah. Abijah's (Abijam's) war with Jeroboam. Note: Jeroboam outlived Abijah by about 2 years, even though his death is mentioned here.
1 Kings 15:7-11 1 Kings 14:19-20 1 Kings 15:25-34	Abijam (Abijah) dies. Asa reigns in Judah. Jeroboam is still alive when Asa becomes king. Jeroboam dies. His son Nadab reigns in Israel. Nadab and all his relatives are murdered. Baasha seizes the throne in Israel.
2 Chron. 14 & 15; 16:1-10	Events during the reign of Asa, King of Judah.
1 Kings 16	Elah, Zimri, Omri, and Ahab: Four kings who reigned in Israel, while King Asa reigned in Judah.
2 Chron. 16:11-14 2 Chron. 17	Asa dies. Jehoshaphat begins his reign in Judah. (Cp. 1 Kings 22:41)
