ANSWER THESE QUESTIONS AFTER YOU HAVE READ THIS MATERIAL:

1. How important to Josiah was the finding of the Book of Moses in the temple?

2. Why did Josiah feel free to consider himself in authority over the Israelites in both the northern and southern parts of Canaan?

3. God promised Josiah that he would go to his grave in peace. Did he? Explain your answer.

4. Name a character in your reading to whom God may have been speaking in Zephaniah 2:3.

5. In Zephaniah 2:13, God says Nineveh would be destroyed. He said the same thing long before now through the prophet Jonah, but changed His mind when they repented. This time, however, the destruction came to pass. But do you think He would have changed His mind again if they had repented at Zephaniah's preaching the way they repented at Jonah's?
