2 John 1

- ¶1. The elder to the chosen lady, and her children, whom I love in truth, and not only I, but also all who have known the truth,
- 2. because of the truth that abides within us, and it will be with us forever:
- 3. Grace, mercy, and peace will be with us, in truth and in love from God the Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ, the Father's Son.
- ¶4. I was overjoyed to find some of your children walking in the truth, just as we received commandment from the Father.
- 5. And now, I entreat you, lady (not as though I am writing a new commandment to you, but that which we have had from the beginning), that we love one another.
- 6. And this is love, that we live by His commandments. This is the commandment, which you have heard from the beginning, that you should live in it.
- 7. For many deceivers are gone out into the world, those who do not confess Jesus Christ when he comes into a person; this is the deceiver and the anti-Christ.
- 8. Take heed to yourselves, lest we lose the things we have worked for, but that we may receive a full reward.
- 9. Everyone who turns aside and does not remain in the doctrine of Christ does not have God; he who remains in the doctrine of Christ has both the Father and the Son.
- 10. If anyone comes to you not carrying this doctrine, do not receive him into your house, and do not offer him a greeting,
- 11. for he who welcomes him partakes of his evil deeds.
- ¶12. Although I have many things to write to you, I would rather not use paper and ink; however, I do hope to come to you and talk face to face, so that our joy might be full.
- 13. The children of your chosen sister greet you. Amen.
