#### **6. THE TABERNACLE** (Ex. 26: 1-14; 36: 8-19)

NOTE: The tabernacle "roof" was 4 layers thick. The first layer was made of "fine-twined linen". The fine-twined linen was made up of large pieces, called "curtains", and then was put together. Layers #2, 3, & 4 were called "coverings." These were also made up of large pieces, called "curtains", joined together to form each separate layer of covering for the tabernacle. A cubit equals about 18 inches.

Layer # 1: The layer of Fine-Twined Linen
