

# NUMBERS 20-36

**READING:** NUMBERS 20-36 (read in the order given here)

Note: The “Forty Years in the Wilderness” passes for the most part in silence between Chapters 14 and 20.

Numbers 20:1-13, then . . .

***Deuteronomy 2:1-7*** (the 40<sup>th</sup> year since the Israelites left Egypt).

Numbers 20:14 *through* 21:11, then . . .

***Deuteronomy 2:8-13*** (the 38<sup>th</sup> year since camping in Kadesh-Barnea).

Numbers 21:12, then . . .

***Deuteronomy 2:14-25***

Numbers 21:13-20, then . . .

***Deuteronomy 2:26-37***

Numbers 21:24-32, then . . .

***Deuteronomy 3:1-11***

Numbers 22-25 Balaam and the Sin of Baal-Peor.

Numbers 26 The Second Numbering.

(with chapter 26, complete the “Numbering of the Army” sheet you already have - #1092)

Numbers 27 The daughters of Zelophehad complain and obtain justice from God.

Numbers 28-29 Laws concerning sacrifices for special days.

Numbers 30 Concerning vows.

Numbers 31 Moses avenges Israel of the Midianites.

Numbers 32 Reuben, Gad, and half of Manasseh want trans-Jordan.

Numbers 33 The list of Israel’s camping places during the Forty Years.

Notice that we are told here (v. 3) that the Exodus began at Raamses, in Egypt, on the fifteenth day of the first month.

Numbers 34 God tells Moses what the borders of Canaan are to be.

Numbers 35 Levitical cities, including the Cities of Refuge.

Numbers 36 The elders of Manasseh complain about God’s judgment concerning Zelophehad’s daughters, and they, too, receive justice from God.

**GEOGRAPHY:**

- Num. 20:1 **Desert of Zin** (= Wilderness of Zin, p. 59, T-2)  
**Kadesh-barnea.**
- Deut. 2:1 Red Sea.  
Deut. 2:4 **Seir** (Edom's land).
- Num. 21:3 **Hormah**  
Numbers 21:10-11 Here, notice only that the Israelites were going to travel east ("toward the sunrising" of Moab.
- Deut. 2:8 **Elath is the same as Ezion-gaber** (p. 71, F5). To get around Edom, Israel had to swing far to the south, close to the Red Sea, then go northeast, around Moab.  
Deut. 2:9 **Ar** (p. 57, Y6).  
Deut. 2:13 **the brook called Zered** (p. 57, Y7).  
Deut. 2:19 Ammon.  
Deut. 2:24 Arnon River.
- Num. 21:18 Mattanah (p. 57, Y5).  
Num. 21:19 Nahaliel is a creek running into the Salt Sea (p. 57, Y5).  
Num. 21:19 Bamoth (same as Bamoth-Baal, p. 63 Y5).  
Num. 21:20 **Mt. Pisgah** (p. 63, Y5).
- Deut. 2:26 **Heshbon** (p. 63, Y5)  
Deut. 2:32 **Jahaz** (p. 63, Y5. This is south of Heshbon, on a river bank.)  
Deut. 2:36 **Aroer, Gilead.**  
Deut. 2:37 Jabbok.
- Num. 21:30 Dibon (p. 63, Y6), Medeba (p. 63, Y5).  
Num. 21:32 Jaazer (= Jazer, p. 63, Y4).
- Deut. 3:1 **Bashan, Edrei** (p. 62, Z3).  
Deut. 3:4 **Argob** (p. 65, an area found in both Y3 and Z3).  
Deut. 3:8 **Mt. Hermon** (p. 65, Y2).  
Deut. 3:10 Salcah (= Salecah, east of Bashan, p. 71, G4).  
Deut. 3:11 Rabbath (= Rabbah, p. 63, Y5).
- Num. 22:1 Jordan River,  
Num. 22:1 **Jericho** (p. 57, X5. "by Jericho" means "across from Jericho")  
Num. 22:5 Pethor is in **Syria** (Syria was also called "**Aram**", as in 23:7).

- Num. 22:30 Kirjath-huzoth is a place somewhere in Moab.  
 Num. 23:5 Aram (= Syria).  
 Num. 23:28 **Baal-Peor** (p. 63, Y5).  
 Num. 23:28 Jeshimon (= **Beth-Jeshimoth**, 63, Y5).  
 Num. 25:1 **Shittim**.
- Num. 32 The tribes of Reuben, Gad, and half the tribe of Manasseh wanted the territory east of Jordan, from the Arnon northward into Bashan, for their possession instead of land within Canaan's borders. Moses reluctantly agreed to it.
- Num. 34:3-5 The Southern border of the Promised Land of Canaan.  
**Wilderness of Zin up to the border of Edom.**  
**The southeastern tip of the Salt Sea.**  
**Akkrabim (p. 57, X7)**  
**Kadesh-barnea.**  
**Hazar-addar (p. 59, T2).**  
**The Brook of Egypt to the Great Sea.**
- Num. 34:6 **The Western border.**  
 Num. 34:7-9 The Northern border.  
 Num. 34:10-12 The Eastern border.  
 Question: *Did the Lord consider the Sea of Chinnereth to be inside the Promised Land or just on the border of it? What about the Jordan River?*
