Summary of Truths About God From Psalms 2095

Maybe at creation Adam knew God, but not long after that time the knowledge of God was lost, as men pursued their own machinations. God's nature and His will, His habitation, and His intentions are all matters of which we are now born ignorant. The truth about God must be revealed to us; otherwise, we simply do not know Him. Truths about God which are revealed in Psalms are taken for granted very often because in this Christian culture those revealed truths are propagated. It may be a good exercise in faith to try to imagine how one's life might be different without the knowledge of God which is revealed to the reader from the book of Psalms alone. The following are truths about the Creator which Psalms reveals, truths which improve our lives simply because they improve our understanding of the Almighty.

God is a being Who will never be replaced nor experience death. His is an eternal life. If we did not know this, how would we imagine that He would be replaced if He did die, or was overthrown the way Zeus managed to overthrow the Titans? This is what ancient cultures tried to explain with their mythological tales of heavenly wars in the prehistoric heavens. And it is only one example we use to demonstrate that where revelation is lacking, imagination often fills the void.
