2Sam. 7 David's House

Fearing to harm God's servants is good:

1Chron. 16:14-22

ex. 1Kgs. 13:4-6; 2Kgs. 2:23-24

Obeying His servants is better, even if it hurts them:

ex. 1Kings 20:35-38; Jonah

But fearing God is best:

ex. Jer. 35

The blessing of the Rechabites is equivalent to the "sure mercies" of David = eternal name

2Chronicles 6:42

Isa. 55:3

Acts 13:33-34

LESSON #4: “UNLAWFUL” MERCY

Deuteronomy 17:14-20, Law forbidding
Israel’s king from having many wives.

David’s many wives:

1Sam. 25:42-44 and 2Sam. 3:2-5
and now, Uriah’s wife.

2Sam. 11 David’s sin.

Murder: Ex. 21:12-14; Num. 35:30-31

Adultery: Lev. 20:10

2Sam. 12:1-13 David’s Judgment.

“God has put away thy sin. Thou shalt not die”

There was no such grace allowed in the Law.

PUTTING AWAY/TAKING AWAY SIN

Jn. 1:29: “taketh away the sins of the world”
Isa. 4:4: prophecy of Jesus’ return (Zech. 13:9)
Hos 14:2: another
Acts 3:19: “when the times of refreshing
shall come” (Isa. 28:11-12).

1Cor. 6:9-11 “ye are washed”

Rev. 1:5 “washed us from sins”

Ps. 51

= David became a mystery to everyone, including himself.
After the confusion left by Saul, Israel needed to be purged.
= a test of the hearts.

2Sam. 13- David’s Perpetual Punishment
